	1/4 hr. = \$ 9.59	
	1/2 hr. = \$ 19.18

<b>Other Fees:</b>		
Dumpster Fee:	\$40.00 per pick up load	Used mainly to haul items left behind, i.e. couches, tables, chairs, etc.
Mattress Disposal Fee:	\$35.00 each	
Electronic Disposal Fee:		Based on current waste/recycling fees
Recycling Fee:	\$20.00 per appliance	Washers, dryers, freezers, microwaves, television set, etc. Total cost to resident will include actual labor costs, based on Laborer rate of \$28.92 per hour plus recycling fee
Call-Out Rate:	\$115.00 per call-out 2 hour minimum @ time and 1/2	This cost reflects labor charge for maintenance mechanic to complete work after normal working hours and is the responsibility of the resident.

Note: Hourly rates include operational costs. Charges are to be made as consistently as possible and will be the responsibility of the Working Foreman and financial approval of the Director of Technical Services.

Dumpster, mattress and recycling fees may change if rates increase or decrease during the year.
